New Mexico Voices for Children Announces Hiring of Former Bureau Chief, New Mexico Department of Labor, to Head Research Department

Albuquerque – New Mexico Voices for Children has named Gerry Bradley as its new Research Director. Bradley brings more than 25 years experience as a senior researcher economist for the state. Most recently he directed the Economic Research and Analysis Bureau of New Mexico’s Department of Labor for five years, and worked for the department for ten years as a labor economist.

Bradley will direct New Mexico Voices for Children’s Research Department and conduct research and analysis on state budget, tax, workforce and economic development issues, as well as on social policy issues. He replaces Kelly O’Donnell in that position.

In addition to his work with the Department of Labor, Bradley worked as an analyst for the New Mexico Human Services Department, as well as for the Taxation and Revenue Department.

Bradley’s expertise includes employment forecasting, budget issues for social programs, tax policy, job growth and wage analysis, unemployment insurance reform, poverty trends, the federal and state system of employment and social statistics. He has a Masters Degree in Economics from the University of New Mexico.
